## **Align with His plan.**

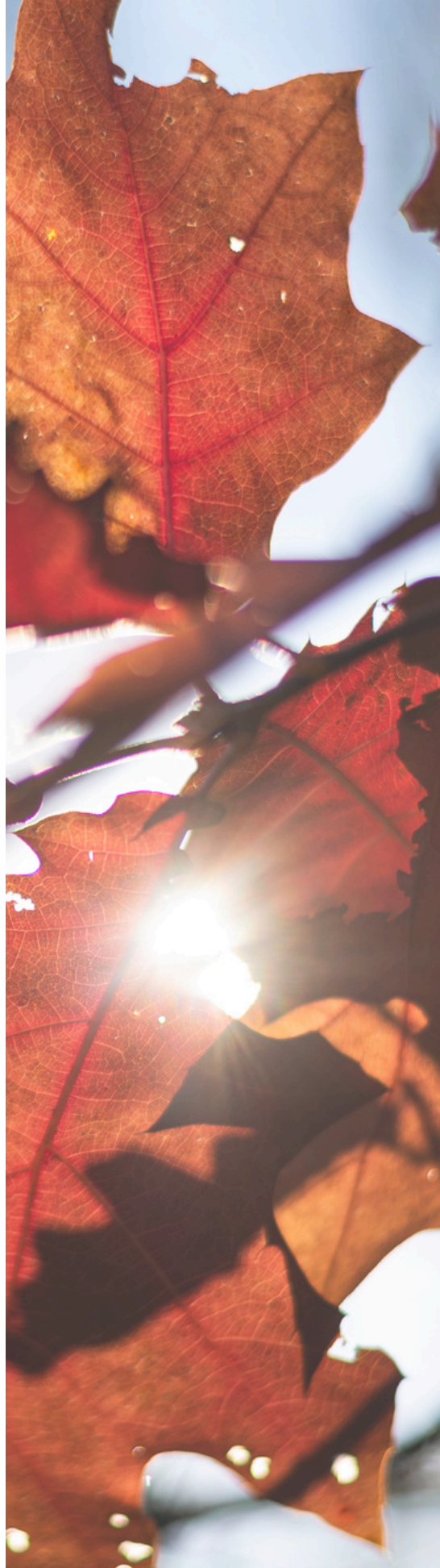

*"Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble."*

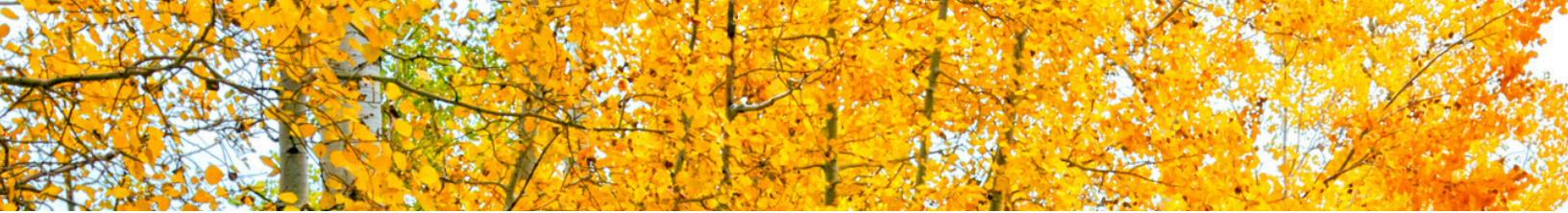
Through fellowship, we deepen our connection with God and with each other.
